What is remote car jamming?

Remote car jamming is a practice where criminals use a signal-jamming device to prevent a car's central locking and alarm systems from being activated, leaving a vehicle vulnerable to theft and vandalism.

Tips to avoid becoming a victim of car jamming:

- Be aware of the surroundings at all times and take note of suspicious persons or activity in and around the parking area.
- Report suspicious activity to centre management or security.
- Do not leave valuables in an unattended vehicle.
- Never push the remote locking while walking away from the vehicle.
- Check that the vehicle is locked by testing the door before walking away, and ensure the boot is locked.
